In her dancing and instruction she combines a deep knowledge of tango technicality with a dynamic and musically expressive style.

She has dedicated time to investigate the teaching methodology of the different tango combinations and technique as well as the social interaction between the two dance partners finding ways to make it easy and fun for the tango aficionados to learn and enjoy social dancing. In her years of tango experience, she has performed and taught tango and milonga at numerous events and festivals in the USA
